Online electronic bids for Contract No. T-730A – Southern Operations and Maintenance Facilities Improvements, Trenton-Morrisville Salt Operations will be received by the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission through the online service Bid Express **until 2:00 p.m. (Local Time) on Thursday March 5, 2020**. At that time, all bids submitted through Bid Express will be publicly opened and read at the Bridge Commission’s Administration Building located at 1199 Woodside Road, Yardley, PA 19067. **No paper bids will be accepted.**

The Scope of Work for the Trenton/ Morrisville Salt Shed and Site Appurtenances project includes, but is not limited to, the following: Construction of a new 500 ton salt storage shed with new MgCl storage tank and fueling station with canopy as well as site work for the new salt operations area. More specific items of work include, but are not limited to:

- Proposed New Salt Shed
- Lightning protection system
- Improve site work for new salt operations area including fence
- New fueling island canopy and fuel dispensing pumps
- New MgCl tank with spray bar
- All work as detailed in the contract documents.

Beginning Monday February 3, 2020, Contract Documents may be obtained online from Bid Express via a link on the Commission’s website (www.drjtbc.org) in the “Doing Business” section, under “Notice to Contractors”.

Bidders are encouraged to have an officer or an authorized representative of their company in attendance at a pre-bid meeting on Monday, February 10, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission’s Administration Building, 1199 Woodside Rd Yardley, Pennsylvania 19067.

Bidders are invited to attend the facility walk-through meeting at the site, which will begin immediately following the pre-bid meeting. Those attending must have the proper safety attire.

Bidders must comply with all the above requirements in order to submit a proposal for this contract.

All questions about the meaning or intent of the Contract Documents shall be directed, in writing, to Roy Little, P.E., Chief Engineer, Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission, Administration Building, 1199 Woodside Rd, Yardley, Pennsylvania, 19067, Attention: Rany Zakharia, P.E., Project Manager. Written questions received later than **3:00PM, Friday, February 14, 2020** will not be answered. Replies will be issued only by Addenda, e-mailed, and posted on the Bid Express website no later than **Thursday, February 20, 2020** to all parties recorded by the Engineer as having obtained the Contract Documents. Only questions answered by formal written clarifications will be binding. Oral and other interpretations or clarifications will be without legal effect. No oral questions will be accepted, all questions must be in writing. All inquiries during the bidding period should reference Contract No. T-730A, Capital Project 0818A, Southern Operations and Maintenance Facilities Improvements, Trenton Morrisville Salt Operations.

The Commission reserves the right to waive any information in the bids received; to reject any or all bids; to retain the bids for a period up to ninety (90) calendar days after receipt of the bids prior to making award; and to award the contract only to those experienced in this class of work, and to the lowest responsible bidder whose proposal is deemed by the Commission to be the most advantageous to the public interest.
